survival was highest among those diagnosed with cancer before age 45 years (81%) and decreased with increasing age (Table 2) Among the most common cancer sites, 5-year relative survival was highest for prostate cancer (97%) and breast cancer (88%), intermediate for colorectal cancer (63%), and lowest for lung cancer (18%) (Table 2)
